We will try to use the correct punctuation for our sentences

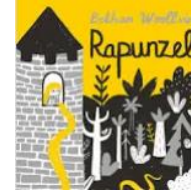
We will use 'and' to join words and to make our sentences more interesting.

## ART/DT

In Art we will be developing our drawing and painting skills to produce a portrait.

Vocab: primary colours, secondary colours, paint, pencil, colour mixing.

In DT we will use mechanisms to create a moving object.

Vocab: mechanisms, design, movement.

## History

In History the children will use artefacts, stories, pictures and online sources to find out about the past. They will look at how the past is represented and think about how to place events onto a timeline. We will find out about Rosa Parks and think about why she is an important part of History.

Vocab: Past, timeline, date, evidence

## Science



In Science the children be continuing to monitor the weather as the seasons slowly change. We will also be learning about ourselves and our five senses.

Vocab: rainfall, climate, temperature, thermometer, sight, hearing, touch, smell, taste, eyes, ears, tongue, nose

## RE



In RE lessons we will be learning about books and stories that are special to us and how we should look after them. We will think about how the Qur'an is special to Muslims and how the Bible is special to Christians.

Vocab: holy, moral, special, Bible, Qur'an.

## PE

Our PE topic for this half term is gymnastics. We will develop knowledge of different gymnastic balances and develop our ability to hold balances. We will create routines using difference balances and will work on our ability to move from one balance to another, demonstrating good control.
