## Grammar

We will focus on:

Formation of nouns using suffixes e.g. -ness, -er and by compounding

Use of the suffix -ly to turn adjectives into adverbs

## Geography

In geography, children will look at what it is like to live by the coast. They will name and locate the seas and oceans, locate UK coasts on a map and identify physical and human features.
