English

Reading - We will read every day with your child/ren during our phonics sessions.

Phonics - Will be taught every day to support recognising letters, blending and segmenting, which will support reading and spelling. Writing - In literacy, we will be using our taught phonics to write simple sentences.

Grammar and punctuation - Will be taught alongside writing.

Maths

We follow The White Rose Scheme of learning at Shelley First School. This term children will be tauaht:

Place Value Addition and Subtraction Geometry: Shape

Counting in 1s, 2s, 5s, 10s to 100 and number bonds to and within 10 will be taught and practised throughout the week.

Science

Who am I?

Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body. Say which part of the body is associated with each sense. Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.

Celebrations

Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday

Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants.

Art and D.T

Drawing – Portraits

Building on close observation to create a self-portrait.

Children choose and mix their own colours to create a piece of art after exploring the work of two abstract artists, Jackson Pollock and Sonya Delaunay.

Festive Card with sliding part

Children will design a purposeful, functional, festive card based on design criteria; include a sliding part.

Geography

Our Local Area

Know about the local area, and name and locate key landmarks. Recognise a natural environment and describe it using key vocabulary. Describe a journey on a map of the local area using simple compass directions and locational and directional language.

History

My Family History

Know where the people and events they study fit within a chronological framework.

Understand some of the ways in which we find out about the past.

PSHE and RSE

Being me in my world

Understand the rights and responsibilities as a member of my class. Know how to make my class a safe place for everybody to learn. Know my views are valued.

Recognise how it feels to be proud of an achievement.

Recognise the choices I make and understand the consequences. Recognise the range of feelings when I face certain consequences.

What makes a good helper?

Understand the need for rules at home, school and in the wider world. Think of ways we can help one another. Understand the meaning of 'friendship'

Learn about Jesus special friends.

Learn about Jesus' teaching of God.
