It is proven that children make accelerated rates of progress when they talk about their learning/learn with their parents or carers. To enable this we are providing you with information about what the children are learning and what they may need to prepare/practice at home.



SCHOOL THEME: FRIENDSHIPS



English – this includes reading, writing, phonics, grammar, punctuation, speaking and listening

Our topic this half term is suspense and mystery writing, using the text Coraline. We will be learning:

- How to analyse characters
- How to analyse text
- Creating our own characters and texts
- The associated spelling, punctuation and grammar with the features of these



Maths – this includes learning about using maths in real life situations

We will be learning:

- Find the area and perimeter of shapes.
- Identify lines of symmetry in 2D shapes.
- Read and write analogue and digital times.
- Solve addition and subtraction problems.
- Adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator.
- Construct and interpret different types of graphs.
- Answer questions about data.



Science

Our Science topic is Ecosystems.

We will learn about what an ecosystem is first and foremost before going on to learn about different types of ecosystems around the world. We will learn technical terms such as biomes and investigate a range of food chains.

Geography

The children will be learning all about different climatic hazards or natural disasters. As well as studying the geographical and scientific causes of these, students will have chance to learn about real-life case studies where some of these things have happened.

Work will be linked in to learning about how we can protect ourselves from some of these dangers and how they might be prevented in the future by taking more care of our planet.

Work Experience

This term the children have an exciting opportunity to visit the Donkey Sanctuary at Sutton Park. Here they will learn what it takes to look after animals and have the chance to help take care of them. The work there will also be linked in with different emotions and social skills as they work together to take care of the donkeys.
