PUPIL PREMIUM GRANT

These outcomes are based on the Pupil Premium children we had at our school in the academic year 2020-2021. The pupil premium grant for 2020-2021 was £30,040. The numbers of PP children can differ during terms.

Subject Area	% of Pupil Premium children who made expected or above progress (34 children)	Whole School (40 children)
Mathematics – Overall Yearly progress to date	82% Only 6 of those 34 PP students did not achieve G/O. 5 of those had attendance below 80%	84%
English – Overall Yearly progress to date		71%

Interventions that were taken by PP students in the 20-21 academic year included:

- On site mechanics
- In the house/online 1:1 maths/english tuition
- KRUNCH
- 1:1 Maths/English with teachers
- 1:1 interventions with LSPs
- 1:1 SEMH interventions with play therapist
- 1:1 Psychotherapy sessions
- Mentor sessions with Jonah’s project on site
- Startrite
- TUTE online tuition sessions

Summary

Pupil Premium (PP) children performed better than our non-PP children in Maths but not in English. This is due mainly to those PP students (47%) having an increased amount of below 80% attendance than the rest of school.

Plans for 2021-2022

The Brades Lodge site has £30,040 Pupil Premium grant, which will be spent on the following:

- Well Being support interventions given by WBST/LSPs allocated on need.
- Maths intervention
- English interventions
- Speech and Language assessments
- Dyslexia Screening
- On site Mechanics sessions
- Music lessons
- Links to external professionals – School Nurses, Occupational Therapy, Educational
 - KRUNCH Sessions
 - Startrite
 - Sessions with Jonah’s Project Mentoring Programme
 - Play therapist
 - Psychology – buying in additional support as and when needed
 - Home Tuition and sessions online for TUTE
