

Statement of Curriculum Intent Shenstone Lodge School

Our curriculum is ambitious and has been devised to allow students to develop resilience, confidence and independence, as well as achieve scholastic and personal outcomes, that will enable them to move on to further education or the workplace and make a positive contribution to society.

Students across all key stages are able to access a wide range of academic subjects and pastoral activities that are adapted, where appropriate, to suit their individual SEMH needs.

Children and students benefit from tailored and personalised educational programmes which are underpinned by the National Curriculum, in an environment where they know they are valued and safe.

It is our intention to ensure all students leave the school with the emotional resilience and academic skills that will support them to achieve their career and educational aspirations.

IMPLEMENTATION

Pupils have access to a well sequenced curriculum that reinforces and builds on students' knowledge from their starting points.

Literacy and numeracy are taught discretely and through all subjects to maximise opportunities to develop the necessary skills to become successful communicators, readers and be mathematically competent. Specific interventions are delivered to students who are require additional support.

The safety of our pupils is paramount and underpins everything we do; safeguarding in its broadest sense is addressed explicitly through RSE/PHSE lessons, assemblies and through interventions.

The school's pastoral offer is substantial and wide reaching. Lessons and bespoke interventions are designed as far as possible to proactively meet the mental health and other needs of students and to ultimately remove potential barriers to learning.

We expect high quality teaching and learning as standard, and provide professional development designed to further improve and continually develop our educational offer.

IMPACT

Students' progress is accelerated overtime from their starting point, closing the gap against National Benchmarks.

Students' outcomes are maximised to achieve the required skills, knowledge and accreditations to support them to achieve their ambitions and next steps.

Students, where possible, achieve recognised tests and accreditations such as: SATs, GCSEs, BTECs and Functional Skills awards.


Students are emotionally ready for the next stage of education, employment or training.


