ACADEMIC SUPPORT

- All year groups at the academy have a Year Lead, part of this role is focused on identifying gaps in knowledge and inputting interventions to support progress.
- In the event of academic support being required, subject teachers would complete a Sixth Form Impact Meeting (SIM)
- A SIM is a target setting exercise which is undertaken with the subject specialist and the student, a copy of the targets set are also sent to parent/guardians.
- SIM's are recorded on the academy system and can be viewed by the Sixth Form Team, Tutors and Subject teachers.
- Should the targets set not be met, the same process would take place with the Team Leader.
- Should the targets set not be met, the final stage in the process would be for the Sixth Form Team to meet with parent/guardians to discuss next steps.

CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT

- If a Sixth Form student is not meeting behavioural expectations, the member of staff would log a negative event on Bromcom.
- Negative points would be issued for events such as: Lateness to lesson, Lateness to school, phone use in lessons, not wearing a lanyard, not following academy expectations, not responding to a warning, uniform infringement.
- A detention level point would be added for truancy or removal from lesson, although we do not sit detentions in Sixth Form, this would trigger an automatic notification to parents/guardians and the issue would be picked up by the Sixth Form Team.
- For consistency and fairness we also use a staged warning system should these be necessary, these echo the world of work.

Level 1- Verbal Warning
Level 2- Written Warning
Level 3- Final Written Warning
Level 4- Removal from Sixth Form

In the event of serious conduct issues, the Sixth Form Team will issue formal warnings which may not follow each level consequentially.

PRAISE AND REWARDS

- Positive Points added on Bromcom
- Termly reward events for those demonstrating desired behaviours
- End of year events such as BBQ events, Trips, Prom etc
- Those achieving effort and on track performance in all subjects receive offsite privileges from 2pm where timetables allow.
