My name is Miss Zabiela. I have a daughter who is 10 years old and a pet tortoise called Beetroot.

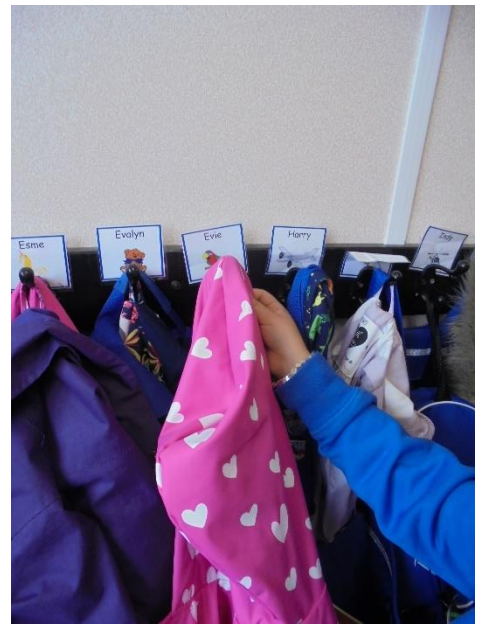
I like keeping myself busy and going to the gym.
