## **English**

#### Reading

Our book study this term will be 'Melt' by Ele Fountain, as well as looking at non-fiction and poetry. We will also be continuing to develop our key skills of retrieval, vocabulary and inference. The non-fiction and poetry will link to the children's understanding of climate change and how this is effecting out planet.
