In Year 3 and 4, children will study Christian and Sikh traditions.

In Year 5 and 6, children will study Christian and Muslim traditions.

Each MTP consists of 5 steps (each of the 5 stages of the enquiry cycle). This is approximately one lesson per step with room for some lessons going over two hours/two lessons. RE should be taught each week and assessments for each child should be made at the minimum at the end of each unit of study.
