Curriculum Achievements

Year 3

Year 3 have settled into junior life exceptionally well. They are getting used to new routines and producing some excellent work. We are so proud of how carefully they are listening and are showing excellent manners. We are starting to look at Forces in Science and learning all about the Ancient Greeks.

Year 4

Year 4 have started this academic year with excitement about the up-and-coming learning across the curriculum. Already we have started learning about how sound travels and enjoyed a practical experiment which shows this in action. The children are also enjoying art lessons, where they are creating their own Matisse collages. In English, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory has been a hit!

Year 5

Year 5 have made a fantastic start to the new school year and have embraced the challenges of Year 5 with enthusiasm. We began the term by exploring our class book, *The Boy at the Back of the Class*, and the children have written some wonderful character descriptions of the main character, Ahmet. In science, we are thoroughly enjoying our topic on space and have been discovering fascinating facts about the planets and the solar system. In maths, we've been learning about decimal fractions, and the children have approached this with great focus and determination.

Year 6

Year 6 have risen to the challenge of being top of the school, demonstrating excellent behaviour in assemblies and earning their privilege to sit on benches. They have completed their first learning journey exploring free verse poetry, using both informal and figurative language.
