Wider Curriculum

This term is bursting with creativity and reflection! 🗗 In Music, we're rocking out with a focus on Rock and Roll, learning rhythms and performing with style. In RE, we'll explore big questions in our 'God Talk' unit, thinking about how people describe and experience God. In Computing, we'll be making our own animations using digital tools, exploring onion skinning on Purple Mash. PSHE will focus on important topics like healthy sleep habits and sun safety, helping us look after our minds and bodies as we head into summer. 😴 🧶

Maths

This term in Maths, we are focusing on the four operations—addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division—through real-life problems and auick recall of times tables. We are also learning to tell the time to the nearest 1, 5, 15 and 30 minutes using both analogue and digital clocks, as well as solving problems involving durations and simple schedules. In statistics, children are reading and drawing tally charts, pictograms, and bar charts, and using them to compare and interpret information.

PE will be full of teamwork and fastpaced fun this term! In Dodgeball, children will develop agility, coordination, and quick thinking, while Cricket will build their striking, fielding, and collaboration skills. A sporty and action-packed half-term ahead! 🔏 🤾 💨
