



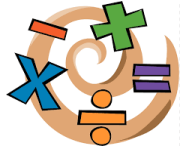
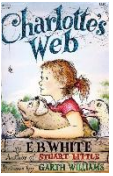

Sholing Junior School Year 3 Autumn 1 Curriculum Newsletter



Overview

Hello and welcome to Sholing Junior School! We are very excited to get to know you all and show you what school life is like in Year 3. We have some brilliant topics to teach you this half term. We can't wait to get started!

 <u>English</u> This half term, children will be using the exciting picture books <i>Leon and the Place Between</i> and <i>Arthur and the Golden Rope</i> as inspiration for their writing. They will explore how authors create engaging stories and develop their own narrative writing, focusing on improving sentence structure, organisation, and descriptive language.	<u>Maths</u>  In Maths, we will be adding and subtracting numbers across 10, moving to looking at numbers up to 100. We focus on counting in 10s, 20s, 50s, representing numbers in a range of ways such as number lines and bar models.	<u>Reading</u> In class, we will be reading <i>Charlotte's Web</i> by E.B White. As well as reading the story, the children will be focusing on retrieving facts from the book, understanding the vocabulary chosen by the author and using inferencing skills to think about character's emotions. 
<u>Wider Curriculum</u> In Science this half term we will be looking at Scientific Enquiry, thinking about developing foundational skills. In Spanish, we will start looking at greetings, numbers and colours. In PSHE, we will be looking at health and wellbeing. 	<u>PE</u> This term in PE, pupils will be developing their fundamental movement skills, including running, jumping, throwing, catching and balancing, while also taking part in team-building activities. Through a range of fun and engaging games, children will build confidence, improve coordination, and learn important skills such as communication, cooperation, and teamwork. Our PE days are Mondays and Fridays.   	<u>Important Dates and Websites</u> Please make sure you are reading with your child 5 times a week and recording this in their reading diary (to follow); ensure your child is practicing their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars and spelling on Spelling Shed. Logins to follow. Spelling tests will be on Fridays.
