Maths	Complete 3 garages on Times Table Rock Stars. 	Create a song/rap about the table you are learning.	Create a number bonds game to play with your friends of family. It could be, for example, number bonds to 10, 50, 100 or even 1000!	Get a person to time you reciting the table you are learning, then record and try and beat that time.	Teach someone at home how to add and subtract using the column method.
Writing	Write a poem about your favourite person, people or place.	Write a paragraph about your weekend.	Imagine you are a character from a movie, write a diary entry about what has happened in your day.	Choose your favourite place. Write some sentences to describe what it looks like, feels like, smells like etc.	Create your own superhero. Write a few sentences about what they look like and their powers.
