Overview

Welcome to Year 6! This half term is a busy and exciting one, as we begin by settling into new routines and expectations for our final year of primary school.

English

As we kick start the year, we are going to dive into exploring the book Wild Boy.



The children will develop their skills in dialogue and narrative writing.

Maths

We will begin Year 6 maths with a place value recap, focusing on multiples up to 1000 and number up to 10,000,000. We will begin practising our arithmetic skills to build both confidence and identify areas for practise.



Reading

Over the course of Autumn 1, we will be focusing on our main reading skills of Inference, retrieval, summarising, authorial choice, prediction and vocabulary. We will look at a range of engaging texts to develop these skills and improve our reading speed and fluency.



Wider Curriculum

In History, we will explore the events of the Industrial revolution – focusing on the inventions and the changes they brought to Britain. In RE, we will



be looking at the concept of 'message' in the religion of Christianity. In Spanish, we will start the year by recapping previous vocabulary.

PE

Our first half-term in year 6, we are going to dive straight into football. Our main focus will be striking and the skill of invasion. This will allow us time to develop our communication, teamwork and sportsmanship. Building on that, we are also going to work further on our team building through games where our success depends on our ability to work together.
