| 1 | <b>Beach</b>     | an area of sand sloping down to the water of a sea or lake                                 |
| 2 | <b>Coastline</b> | a line that forms the edge between the land and the ocean or a lake                        |
| 3 | <b>Forest</b>    | A large area filled with many trees  |
| 4 | <b>Mountain</b>  | A mountain is a landform that rises high above its surroundings. It is taller than a hill. |
| 5 | <b>Valley</b>    | a long depression, or ditch, in Earth's surface  |
| 6 | <b>City</b>      | A large town. Manchester and London are cities   |
| 7 | <b>Town</b>      | A thickly settled area that is usually larger than a village but smaller than a city       |
| 8 | <b>Village</b>   | a place where people live that is usually smaller than a town                              |
| 9 | <b>Harbour</b>   | a deep body of water that protects boats near land   |
