Hot Weather Update

Following on from the text sent this afternoon, we are also emailing the information along with some photographs to ensure all families have a clear understanding of the uniform expectations during this warmer weather. Specifically, we have included images of what is meant by "tailored shorts". Given the high temperatures expected this week, it is important that your child comes to school with sun protection and a filled water bottle. Refilling is allowed at designated points throughout the day. However, we would like to remind students that full school uniform (including trousers/skirts, shirts and a tie) is still expected, and we are willing to make reasonable adjustments in the classroom for comfort.

Please note that non-compliant uniform or PE kits will not be acceptable. In the past, when we have allowed non-school kit during warmer weather, we have experienced unnecessary disruption due to several students coming to school dressed inappropriately. As such, only tailored school uniform shorts will be allowed. We have included picture examples of boys' and girls' school uniform shorts below for reference.
