#### **How is homework set at Sir William Stanier?**

Our homework is usually set as multiple-choice quizzes, covering all the work you have studied in a specific class so far. We will always aim to consolidate your knowledge and understanding of the content you have learned in lessons, ensuring our homework is simple and accessible for everyone.

To complete a quiz, log into your satchel one account and select a quiz from your "To-Do List".


You will be able to pick your answer from the list of options for each question. If your quiz is timed, there will be a Quiz Timer towards the top of the page to count down the time you have left to answer the question. If the time runs out before you make a choice, your answer will be marked as wrong and the answer options will appear in red. Click *Continue* to move onto the next question.

When you finish your results will be available immediately. If you don't receive 100% on your first attempt, you can take the quiz again; you'll get 3 attempts at taking the quiz to improve your test score. You can click on *View results* for a handy breakdown of your attempts.

### How do I use Satchel One?

Our students find Satchel One very straight forward to use. All of your homework is organised in your "To-Do-List" and organised by how soon the piece of homework is due.

## Logging in to Satchel One

You can log into Satchel One from a computer using the following steps:

1. Open a web browser
2. Type in [www.satchelone.com](http://www.satchelone.com)
3. Click the 'Sign in with Office 365 button'
4. Type in your school email address that the school has set up for you which is your normal school log in followed by



**You can log into Satchel One from a phone or tablet using the following steps:**

2. Search for “Sir William Stanier Community School” and select “Sir William Stanier”
3. Click the ‘Sign in with Office 365 and then sign in using your school email address and password




**How can I submit my homework?**

As a student you can submit your assignments online instead of handing them in - as long as your teacher requests an online submission. When they do so, you will see this on your homework:

You can upload documents and images straight from your mobile device with the Show My Homework App.


There is no "Submit" button here, but for online submissions you will see a paperclip next to your comment box.

1. Tap on the *Submit homework* button at the bottom of the screen
2. Select the location for the file, e.g. your picture gallery, a file stored on your phone, Dropbox or Google drive
3. Choose the correct file
4. Tap *Upload*



## What if I'm using a Computer?

That's not a problem! Simply click the submit tab on your chosen piece of homework. Here you can type in your response or upload a file as seen in the image below.
