Dear Parent/Carer,

Firstly, I would like to thank those of you who completed our parent questionnaire for Ofsted. We are waiting for the draft report that should be with us before Christmas, and you should receive the published report in January 2025. We will send this out as soon as we have it.

It is essential to me that we make some rapid changes to the school so that we can be a school that we are all proud of and one that sits at the heart of our community. Over the spring term I will be inviting you into school to meet with me and talk about what you would like to see from the school.

In January, we have decided to take two **INSET days on Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th January**. The school will be CLOSED to pupils, but staff will be on-site for training. One day is the previously planned INSET for February which has been moved and the other is an extraordinary INSET in response to our new systems coming into place from January.

To help to keep you informed of these changes, we would like to invite you into school for a **parent information session**. We will run three sessions so that you can choose which is most appropriate for you. Your child does not need to attend with you as they will receive this information from their teachers on **Wednesday 8**th **January**.

The sessions will take place in G42 at Sir William Stanier School on Wednesday 8th January at 4:30pm, 5:00pm, and 5:30pm. The session will last for 20-minutes, and staff will be available to answer questions at the end of the session. We will be providing a summary leaflet of our new processes that you will be able to take away with you.

In addition, I would like to give you advance notice that there will be a Trust (TLP) INSET for staff on **Friday 11**th **July** when the school will be closed to pupils.

Thank you to those who have already spoken to me and taken the time to discuss their child. I look forward to meeting you in the new term.
