

Sir William Stanier Remote Learning Package



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Overview

Sir William Stanier offers a full remote learning timetable of five hours for students in year 7-11. The two main platforms that the school will be using are SMHW and Office 365 Teams. The following information will support all students getting the most out of their remote learning experience.

For further support logging into either SMHW or Teams, please email KS3@sws.cheshire.sch.uk if your child is in year 7, 8 or 9 or KS4@sws.cheshire.sch.uk if your child is in year 10 or 11.

- Our remote learning timetable reflects a student's timetable when they are in school. To allow teachers time to set up for the Live Learning Events (LLE) all lessons will commence at the following times for all year groups:

Form Time 8:40am	Period 1 9:15am	Period 2 10:15am	Period 3 11:35am	Period 4 12:35pm	Period 5 2:05pm
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- To ensure students can join the right lessons, all links will be posted on SMHW on the day of the LLE
- Students are encouraged to log on five minutes before the lesson and communicate using the Q&A function

How To Get Started

Before you start your LLEs and SMHW tasks you will need to have the following resources ready:

- Pen/Pencil
- Ruler & Rubber
- Lined and plain paper
- Comfortable chair and table
- IT device such as smartphone, laptop or tablet

Your next steps are to then:

1. Log into SMHW – [Click Here](#) for help to log in to SMHW
2. Click timetable to see your lessons
3. Look for red boxes as these are your LLEs (lessons) for the day
4. Click the relevant red box
5. Scroll to the bottom of the page for the link

Student Rules and Expectations

Any breach of the following rules and expectations could lead to your interactive access to Teams and SMHW being restricted:

- Be ready to log-in by 8:40am each day
- Ensure that your parents/carers are aware that you are participating in the live online lesson
- Ensure that you are appropriately dressed and sitting upright – not lying on a bed or sofa
- Remain engaged in the lesson
- Be polite on the Q&A function
- Do NOT share the Teams link with others outside of your school friends
- Do NOT capture the screen

Please also be aware of the following:

- The lesson will be recorded and made available later on [Microsoft Stream](#)
- The “Chat” function has been set to only allow messages to everyone (no private messages) – a copy of anything typed into the chat will be retained by the school and anything that is inappropriate will be communicated to your parents/carers

Attendance

The following timetable is for the whole year group where lessons and LLE Links can be accessed on SMHW. Students will therefore need to attend the subject that they would have if they were in school at that time.



Microsoft Teams Support

Sir William Stanier offers **Microsoft 365** for all students. This means that all students will be able to download the key programmes they need to complete work set on SMHW. This includes, Word, Excel, Powerpoint and our online learning platform – Microsoft Teams etc.

For installing Microsoft on a Computer/Mac

1. Open a web browser
2. Type in **portal.office.com**
3. Type in your school email address that the school has set up for you which is your normal school log in followed by @sws.cheshire.sch.uk eg, *j.fraser.19@sws.cheshire.sch.uk*
4. Enter your password that you would use when logging into a computer at school
 - If you have forgotten your password, please email studentpassword@sws.cheshire.sch.uk with your name and username only
 - A member of the IT Team will call home with your password within 72 working hours
5. Once logged on you will be able to access and download the Microsoft suite. Click the 'Install office' button that can be found on the top right of the webpage and then 'Install Software'

Installing Microsoft on a smartphone or iPad

1. Go to the app store and search for Microsoft Office
2. You can either download the whole suite of Apps or individual Apps eg, word, powerpoint etc
3. Once downloaded, you should be able to log on using your new Microsoft 365 email address and password



Logging on to SMHW

From a computer

From Monday 11th January students will need to log on to SMHW using the following steps.

1. Open a web browser
2. Type in www.satchelone.com

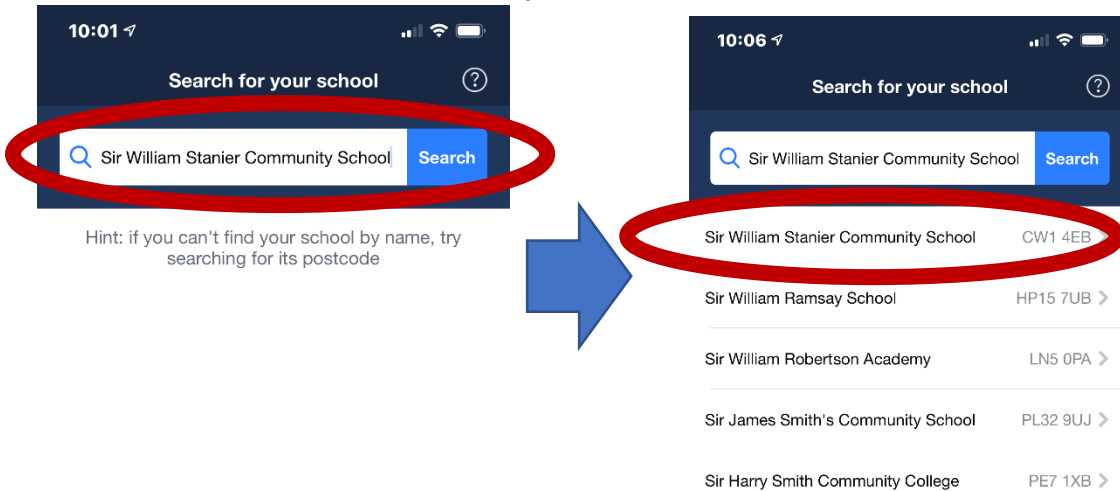
6. A member of the IT Team will call home with your password within 72 working hours

1. Download the satchel: one app (SMHW)
