Live Learning Event Trial – Year 9 and 10

As requested by Parents/Carers and students, we are now investigating the possibility of Live Online Learning Events. This will initially involve year 9 & 10 students over three days next week. We will be trialling a Science (Mon 1st June), English (Tues 2nd June) and Maths (Wed 3rd June) live event starting at 10am. You will receive an email/text at approximately 9:30am on the day of the event with a link for students to access the live event.

During the live event, students will be able to hear their teacher talking through an interactive presentation, students will have the ability to type in any questions they may want to ask for the teacher to respond to. The live event will last approximately one hour. Students do not need a web camera/camera phone for these events as students will not be seen. Just make sure you have some paper and a pen to get started.

SWS will be using Microsoft Teams to broadcast the online learning each day and whichever device students use (E.g. mobile, tablet, laptop, apple mac etc), they will need to have downloaded the Microsoft Teams App CLICK HERE for more details about how to download Teams on a desktop or mobile.

Students will also be able to log onto their newly launched Office 365 accounts and access Teams directly through their web browser. This would be the schools preferred method to use. You do not need to book to attend the live learning event, just wait to receive the link on the day and click to get started.
