Please use the emails above to request any paper copies you need. New work will be constantly uploaded.
- Year 11 Exams As you already know, all year 11 student exams have been cancelled and will not be reinstated. What isn't clear is how students will receive their grades. As a school, we are recommending that all students continue to use SMHW to access and complete as much work as possible and to the best of their ability. The school will then be able to use this to evidence the grades the school predicts each student would have achieved in the summer. The school will give further updates as we receive further information from the government.
- The Year 11 Prom and Leavers Assembly This will still be going ahead; a new date is still to be confirmed. The school will let you know as soon as this has been organised.
