Dear Parents & Carers,

As the Christmas period is fast approaching, I wanted to make sure you had full information about the special events that will be taking place in December. Please find all the information you need below:

Christmas Cards

Most children send each other cards at Christmas, and it is a great opportunity for them to practice their writing. From 1st December, there will be a Christmas postbox on the corridor that children can post their cards into as they come into school. **All cards must be in school by the morning of Wednesday 15th December at the latest.** This will be the final date that we will be able to accept cards. The cards will be sorted and distributed to each class. Each class teacher will provide a list of children's names if you need one. If your child is posting them in the post box, please ensure the envelope has the child's name and class number on so it gets to the right destination!

Christmas Jumper & Dinner Day

School Christmas lunch will be on Wednesday 15th December. All children can come to school in a Christmas jumper or outfit on this day to make it extra festive! For their lunch, children can choose from a Christmas dinner, a roasted vegetable & stuffing tart or they can bring a packed lunch from home. These are the only options on this day. Our cook has sourced halal turkey so children who follow a halal diet are able to have a Christmas dinner. We need orders for lunch on this day to be made by Wednesday 8th December so our cook knows how many dinners we are catering for. If you do not order by this date, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch on that day.

Christmas Concerts

As explained in my email to all parents, we have made the difficult decision to not have a live parent audience for the Christmas performances this year. The performances for all year groups will be recorded during w/c 6th December. If you do not want your child to be included in the video, please ensure you have let us know by Friday 26th November. A donation to cover the cost of our videographer is available on your School Money account. A digital download of the performances will be shared via email before the end of term so you can watch them with your children.
