Dear Parents & Carers,

As the Christmas period is fast approaching, I wanted to make sure you had full information about the special events that will be taking place in December. Please find all the information you need below:

Christmas Cards

Most children send each other cards at Christmas, and it is a great opportunity for them to practice their writing. From 1st December, there will be a Christmas postbox on the corridor that children can post their cards into as they come into school. **All cards must be in school by the morning of Wednesday 14th December at the latest.** This will be the final date that we will be able to accept cards. The cards are sorted and distributed to each class; the classes take turns to do this each day. Each class teacher will be able to provide a list of children's names if you need one. If your child is posting them in the post box, please ensure the envelope has the child's name and class name on so it gets to the right destination!
