Dear Parents & Carers,

As part of our Turrets & Tiaras topic work in September, we have arranged to take Rose, Tulip, Bluebell, Poppy & Snowdrop classes on an educational visit to Conisbrough Castle. During the visit, children will learn about the history of Conisbrough Castle, the types of jobs within a castle and learn about the geography of where castles were built and why they were built in certain places. Children will spend time dressing up, reading plans and drawing the castle during the day. The visit has been organised to give our children a valuable experience which they will then use within their learning within the classroom over the first half term in the autumn. Please find below the dates for each classes visit:

Rose Class & Snowdrop Classes will visit on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2022
Bluebell Class will visit on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2022
Tulip & Poppy Classes will visit on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2022

The coach will leave school at 9.15am prompt and will return at approximately 3.15pm. Children will be back at school for the end of the school day as normal. Your child will need to wear school uniform, a jacket and sensible shoes, either school shoes or trainers. Each class has several places available for parents to support a group of children. Please speak to your child's new class teacher if you can offer your support on the day.

In order for the visit to take place we are asking for a parental contribution of £13.50 per child. This cost consists of £6.50 coach cost; and £7.00 for two educational workshops that the children will take part in at Conisbrough Castle. The visit will be added to your School Money online account during the school holidays, so as to give sufficient time to pay before we come back in September. Should you have any queries with this please do not hesitate to speak to a member of staff in reception. Please note that if sufficient funds are not received by Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September, the visit will have to be cancelled. I do hope that you will be able to support school in our endeavour to offer your children first hand experiences to deepen their learning.

As all of our children are now entitled to Universal Free Meals, they can be provided with a packed lunch on the day of their visit. We will take your orders for a school packed lunch when we return in September as we are in the process of moving over to a new online system with our new caterers, ABM.
