Dear Parents & Carers,

As part of our Enchanted Woodlands topic work, we have arranged to take Classes 1 to 5 on a fabulous educational visit to Austerfield Study Centre in Doncaster. During the visit the children will build dens and create outdoor art. This experience will be used in school to provide a valuable stimulus for children's learning and will consolidate their learning across the curriculum.

Classes 2 & 3 will visit on Monday 21st March 2022 Classes 1 & 4 will visit on Tuesday 22nd March 2022 Class 5 will visit on Wednesday 23rd March 2022

In order for the visit to take place we are asking for a parental contribution of £15.00 per child. The total cost of the visit is £15.50; this consists of £8.00 per child for the Austerfield study centre experience and £7.50 per child for the cost of the coach. However, our school has a policy of charging no more that £15.00 per visit and will therefore subsidise this visit by 50p per child. The visit will be added to your School Money online account and payment will need to be made by Wednesday 16th March 2022. If sufficient funds are not received by this date, sadly we will not be able to allow the visit to go ahead. I do hope that you will be able to offer your support to school in our endeavour to offer your children broad and valuable educational experiences. Should you have any queries with this please do not hesitate to speak to a member of staff in reception. We are very grateful for your support.

Please note that children will need to wear their school uniform as normal. Children will need to wear a warm coat and maybe gloves and a hat as it may be cold. Wellingtons are not necessary. If you would like to offer to support on the visit, please let your child's class teacher know. Places are limited and allocated on a first come first served basis.

As all of our children are now entitled to Universal Free Meals, they can be provided with a packed lunch on the day of the visit. Our school meal provider, Dolce, are committed to 'Natasha's Law' which is a nationally recognised scheme and requires **all food outlets** to provide full ingredient lists with clear allergen labelling on Pre Packed for Direct Sale foods (PPDS). PPDS is food that is prepared, prepacked and offered or sold to consumers on the same premises. Please fill in the attached sheet and return to school by Friday 11th March with your child's sandwich choice and any allergens. If you order a school lunch, please ensure you do not then bring one from home.
