Dear Parents & Carers,

As part of our learning this half term about the wider community and how they help us, we have arranged to take the children from Classes 6, 7 & 8 to The National Emergency Services Museum in Sheffield on Thursday 27th January 2022. The children will be learning about the different kinds of transport that have been used by our Emergency Services in the past. This experience will be used in school to provide a valuable stimulus for children's learning across the curriculum.

In order for the visit to take place we are asking for a parental contribution of £15.00 per child. Entrance into the Emergency Services Museum is £8.00 per child and the cost of the coach to the Museum is £7.00 per child. The visit will be added to your School Money online account and payment will need to be made by Friday 21st January 2021. If sufficient funds are not received by this date, sadly we will not be able to allow the visit to go ahead. I do hope that you will be able to offer your support to school in our endeavour to offer your children broad and valuable educational experiences. Should you have any queries with this please do not hesitate to speak to a member of staff in reception.

Please note that children will need to wear their school uniform as normal. Children will need to wear a warm coat, gloves and hat as it may be cold in the Museum. Wellingtons are not necessary. If you would like to offer to support on the visit, please let your child's class teacher know. Places are limited and allocated on a first come first served basis.

As all of our children are now entitled to Universal Free Meals, they can be provided with a packed lunch on the day of the visit. Our school meal provider, Dolce, are committed to 'Natasha's Law' which is a nationally recognised scheme and requires all food outlets to provide full ingredient lists with clear allergen labelling on Pre Packed for Direct Sale foods (PPDS). PPDS is food that is prepared, prepacked and offered or sold to consumers on the same premises. Please fill in the attached sheet and return to school as soon as possible with your child's sandwich choice and any allergens. If you order a school lunch, please ensure you do not then bring one from home.
