Dear Parents & Carers,

As part of our Proud to be me! topic work in September, we have arranged to take Classes 6, 7 & 8 on an educational visit to Clifton Park on Monday 15th November. During the visit, children will learn about Clifton Park and will take part in an autumn walk around the beautiful grounds. Following this, we have arranged for a visit into school from the Heritage team at Clifton Park Museum to lead a special workshop all about toys from the past. The visits have been organised to give our children a valuable experience which they will then use in their learning within the classroom over the remainder of the term.

The visit will take place during the school day so children will need to be dropped off and collected at the normal times. In order for the visits to take place we are asking for a parental contribution of £9.00 per child. This cost consists of £3.50 for the coach and £5.50 for the workshop. **The visit will be added to your School Money online account and payment will need to be made by Monday 8th November 2021. If sufficient funds are not received by this date, sadly we will not be able to allow the visits to go ahead.** Should you have any queries with this please do not hesitate to speak to a member of staff in reception.

As all of our children are now entitled to Universal Free Meals, they can be provided with a packed lunch on the day of the visit. Your child's class teacher will ask for your child's choice of sandwich nearer the time of the visit. There will be a choice of ham, cheese or tuna filling or you may wish to send a packed lunch from home. If you order a school lunch, please ensure you do not then bring one from home.

I do hope that you will be able to support school in our endeavour to offer your children first hand experiences to deepen their learning.
