Google Classroom – getting started

How to download the Google Classroom app




These instructions will show you how to download Google Classroom on an IOS device (an iPad or an iPhone).

1. Open the App Store on your device:




2. Search for 'Google Classroom' and click 'Get' to download the app:





If you have not previously downloaded the app, your device will show 'Get' here.

3. Open the app and click 'Get started.' Next, sign in with your child's unique username and password. Each child has been allocated with a school google email address and password to log in with. This information has been sent home by Mrs Peart via email. When logging in for the first time, you will need to set a new password for your child's account. Please make this a strong password and do not share this with anyone.




4. You will then be directed to the sign in page, where you will be asked to agree to the Google terms of service.






Click on 'Accept' when you have read and agreed with the conditions.


5. You will then need to select the 'Student' option.




6. This will take you into the app, where it will ask you if you want to receive notifications. If you click to 'Allow' this, you will be notified when a teacher adds something into the classroom.



7. Once you are in the app, your child's Google Classroom should appear, and you will need to click on the 'Join' sign.



8. You can now see your Google Classroom stream. Your child's class teacher will post updates on the class stream, and your child will be able to comment back to them, enabling communication between home and school*.



*Please note that if you have more than one child in school, you will need to log in using each of their Google login's individually to see each classroom.
