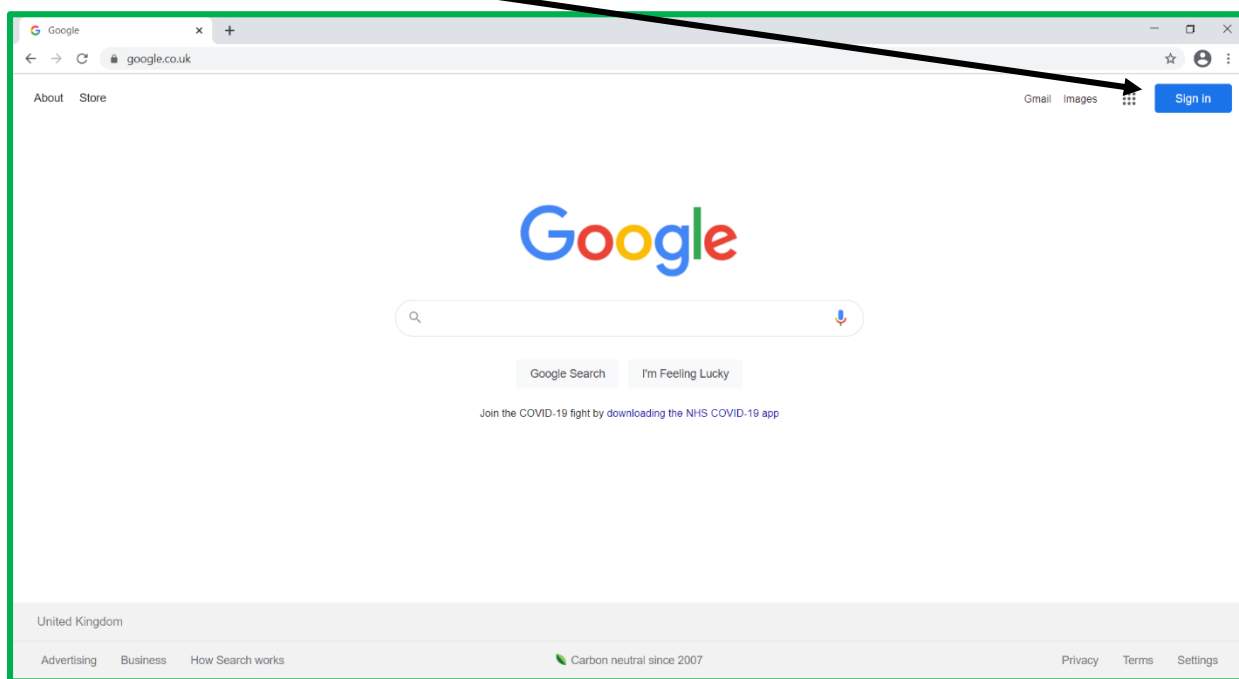




Google Classroom – getting started

How to get onto Google Classroom from a computer or laptop

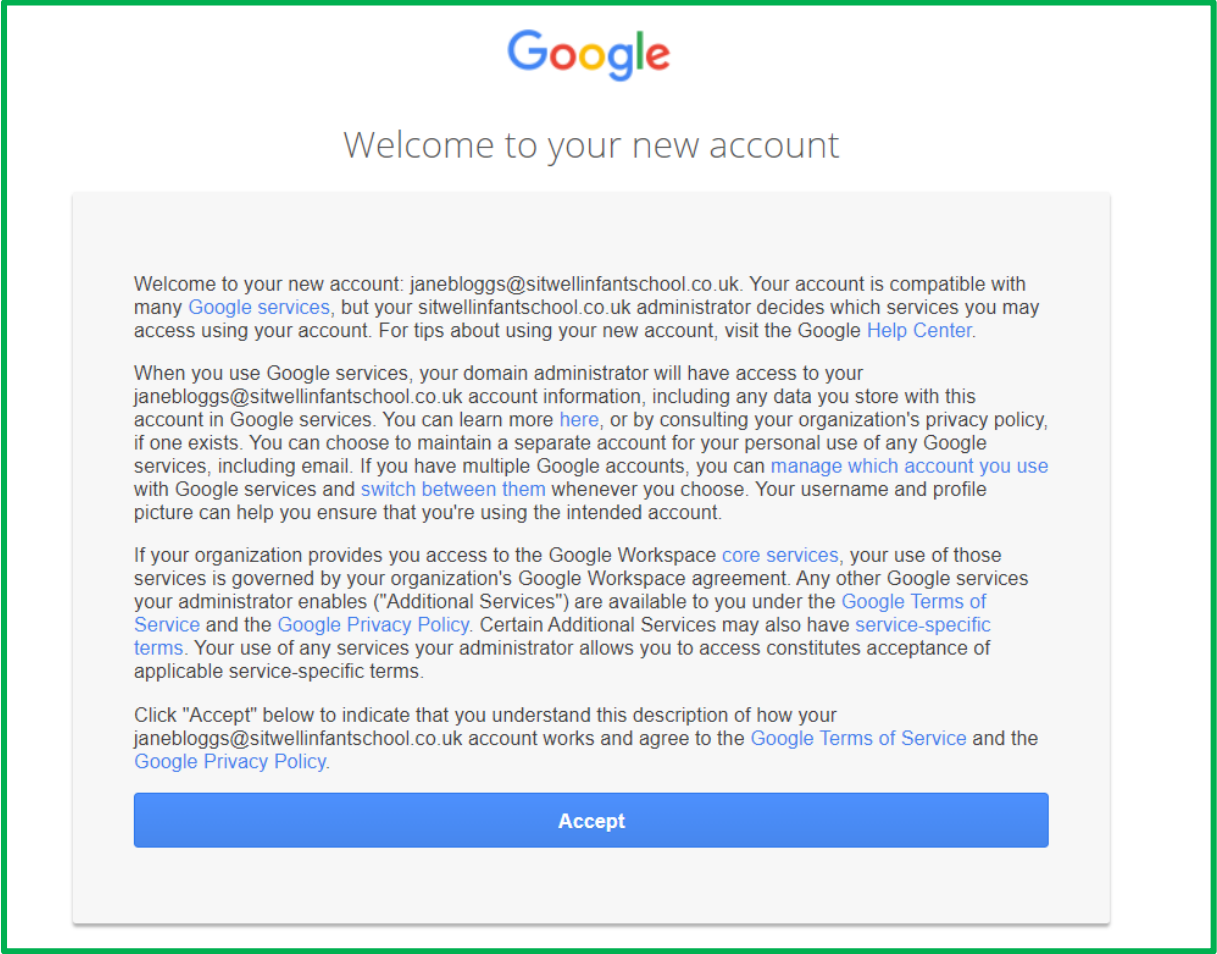
1. Open your internet browser (Chrome, internet explorer etc)
2. Go to www.google.co.uk
3. Click sign in



4. Type in your child's unique school Google account email and password. These will have been emailed to you by Mrs Peart.

Once you have entered these, click Next.

- Next, you will be asked to agree to the Google terms of service. Please click on the 'Accept' button when you have read and agreed to them.

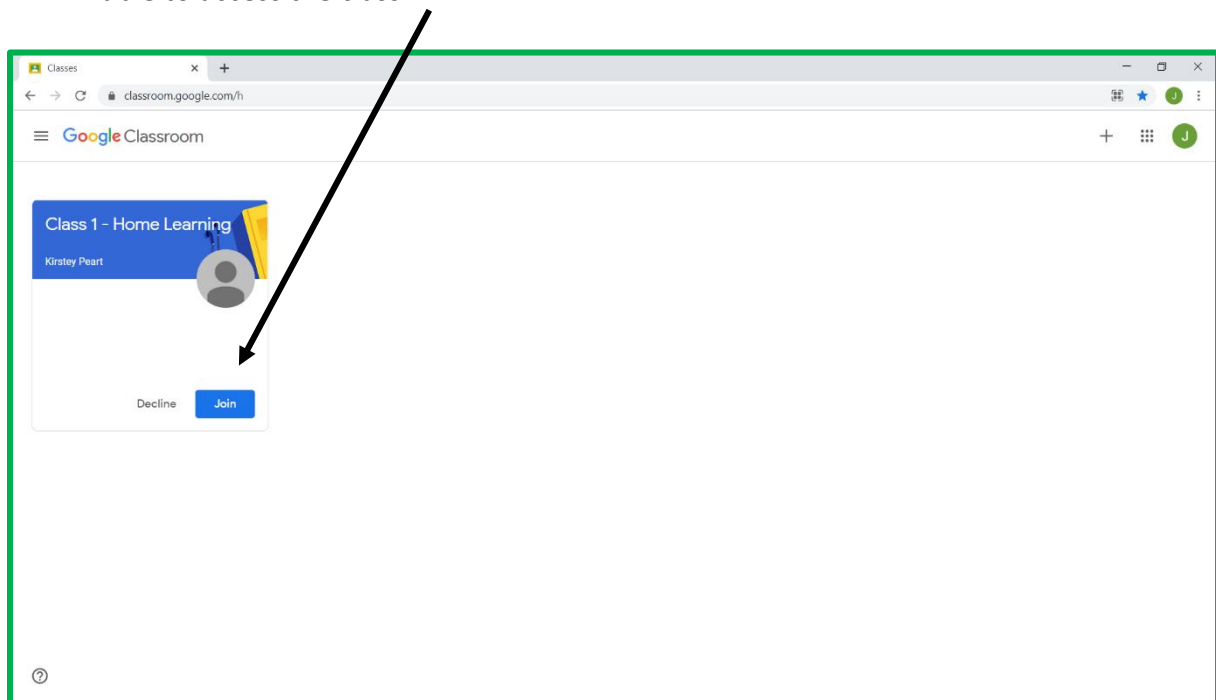
7. Once you have signed in, this will take you back to the Google search page. Type in 'https://classroom.google.com/h' and this page will appear:



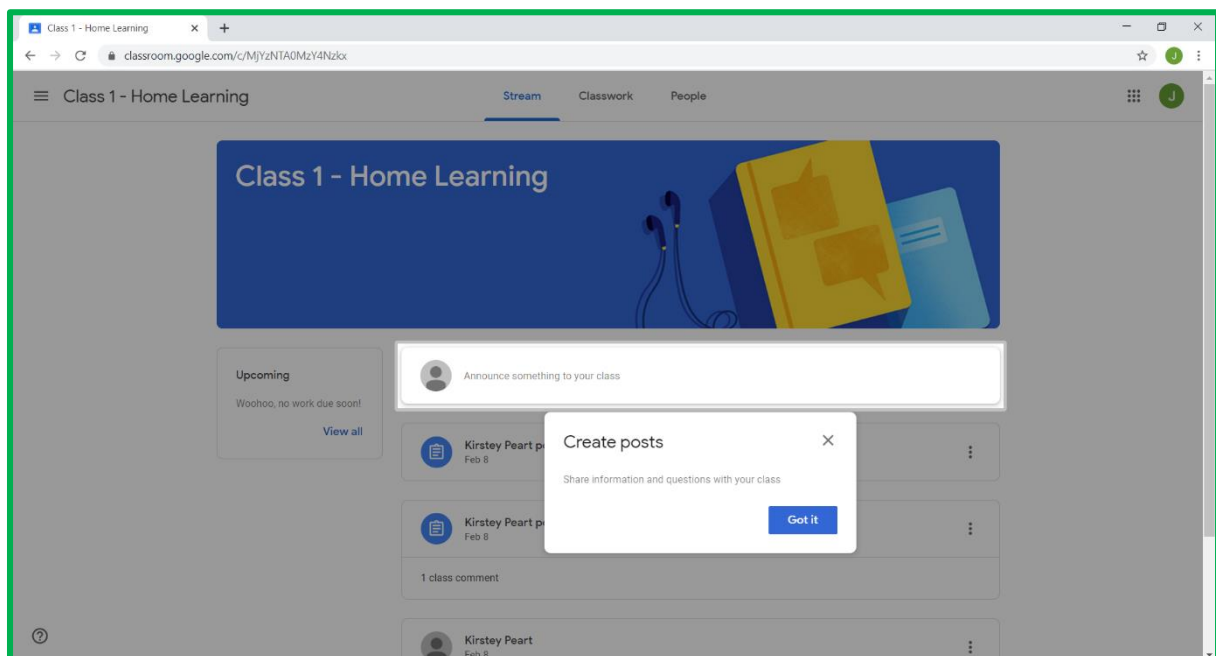
Click 'Continue'. You will then need to choose 'Student'.



8. Your child's virtual classroom will then appear and you just need to click 'Join' to be able to access the class:



9. You can now see your Google Classroom stream. Your child's class teacher will post updates on the class stream, and your child will be able to comment back to them, enabling communication between home and school*.



*Please note that if you have more than one child in school, you will need to log in using each of their Google login's individually to see each classroom.
