Dear Parents & Carers,

As part of our Great Explorers topic work next half term, we have arranged to take Rose, Tulip, Bluebell, Poppy & Snowdrop classes on an educational visit to Magna Science Adventure Centre. During the visit, children will take part in an educational workshop about 'Rockets & Balloons'. Children will develop their scientific knowledge about what makes a rocket move and investigate this using everyday materials.

The visit has been organised to give our children a valuable experience which they will then use to enhance their learning within the classroom. Please find below the dates for each classes visit:

Tulip & Poppy classes will visit on Thursday 2nd March 2023

Rose, Bluebell & Snowdrop classes will visit on Friday 3rd March 2023

The coach will leave school at 9.15am prompt and will return at approximately 3.15pm. Children will be back at school for collection at the end of the school day. Your child will need to wear school uniform, a jacket and sensible shoes, either school shoes or trainers. Each class has several places available for parents to support a group of children. Please speak to your child's class teacher if you can offer your support on the day.

In order for the visit to take place we are asking for a parental contribution of £11.45 per child. This cost consists of £3.95 coach cost; and £7.50 for entry and the educational workshop that the children will take part in at Magna. The visit will be added to your School Money account. Should you have any queries with this please do not hesitate to speak to a member of staff in reception. Please note that if sufficient funds are not received by Friday 24th February 2023, the visit will have to be cancelled. I do hope that you will be able to support school in our endeavour to offer your children first hand experiences to deepen their knowledge and understanding.

As all of our children are now entitled to Universal Free Meals, they can be provided with a packed lunch on the day of their visit. Packed lunches will need to be ordered on Parent Pay by Friday 24th February, in order for the cook to place her order; please ensure you only order a sandwich option on this day.
