We are now in the process of organising provision for next terms after school clubs. There will be new clubs available which we hope will be interesting and exciting for the children to attend. If your child gains a place at a club, we will add payment to your School Money account for you.

Wraparound Care

We are continuing to work on getting wrap around care in place and we are hoping to be able to offer a 'Tea Club' which will run like Breakfast Club each day after school until 5.45pm. We know many parents have showed interest in this. We are looking to appoint new staff to run this provision in the new year and we will keep you posted with developments.
