The School App

We are aware that there are some families who are not yet accessing The School App. This is the main way that we communicate with our families and how we send quick push messages to keep you in the loop about the main things happening in school. If you do not yet have the app, please download this as soon as possible and make sure to read the messages and news sections so you are aware of what is happening each week.

We expect parents to check the app regularly so they are aware of what is happening in school. All events are added in advance to the calendar on the app so you can be aware of what is happening.

After School Provision

Attendance
