# Upcoming Educational Visits

Children will be taking part in their final educational visit of the year this term. If you are able to come with us on these visits, please speak to your child's class teacher to volunteer. These spaces fill up quickly, so please do so as soon as possible.

Children in Rose, Tulip, Bluebell, Poppy & Snowdrop Classes will be visiting Yorkshire Sculpture Park on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June. This visit has an Art & DT focus and will link to the children's learning about Easter Island.

Children in Sunflower, Buttercup & Daisy Classes will be visiting Cannon Hall Farm on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June. This visit has an Understanding of the World focus and will support the children to learn about how a farm works and the kinds of animals you will find on a farm.

### After School Clubs

The after school clubs on offer this half term are limited and parents have been informed if their child secured a place in a club before half term. Please ensure you child is collected at the end of the school day promptly if they are not attending a club.

We do have a few places remaining for our DJ Masterclass club for next half term — this is only suitable for children in Years 1 and 2. This is led by Rotherham Music Service and is £15 for 5 weeks. Please get in touch with the school office as soon as possible if you would like a place for your child.

Some children in Year 1 and Year 2 have been lucky enough to secure a place in our One Voice club, where children will be learning a selection of songs which they will then perform for their parents as part of the One Voice concert on  $23^{rd}$  June. ### Read Write Inc

As you may already be aware, we assess all children every 6 weeks for our Read Write Inc programme. This helps to ensure they are reading books at the appropriate stage, linked to their phonic knowledge. Children were assessed at the end of last half term and have begun in their new groups this week. Some children may

have been ready to move on; some may have remained at the same level. They will be bringing a new book home this week to read with you. We are very grateful for the time you spend reading with your children.

Once children complete the Read Write Inc programme they continue to develop their reading and writing skills in Year 2 groups and are able to choose a wide variety of books to read both in school and at home.
