Parents and carers are more than welcome to join us for Sports Day. We normally finish the morning at about 11.30am. You can stay for the whole session or part of the morning.

# Wraparound Childcare

We are currently working on a wraparound childcare questionnaire so we can gather the views and needs of parents within our school community. At present, we do not offer full wrap around provision as our last information gathering exercise showed that there was not enough need at that time. We are conducting this again to ensure we are taking our current family's needs into consideration. The questionnaire will be emailed out this week. #### Uniform

We wanted to make you aware that due to the first couple of weeks in September being particularly busy, we will not be able to sell uniform during this time. We are asking parents to purchase any uniform they need for September now so that you are fully prepared. Please just log on to your School Money account and go to the shop to do this. If you are unsure about sizing, just pop

into reception and we can show you the items so you can check this for your child. Thank you.

#### Transition Plans

#### Friday 5th July

#### Record of Achievement

Each child will come home with their Record of Achievement, which will detail their end of year assessments, attendance record and a class 'Pen Portrait' will also be included so you and your child are aware of their new class staff team. Children in Year 1 will also have their Phonics Screening Check result and children in F2 will have their EYFS Profile results.

# Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July – Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July Transition visits

All children in school will move up to their new class for three full days. You will bring and collect your children as normal and we will organise them into their new classes once we have taken the register in their existing classroom. Children will then return to their class at the end of the day ready for collection at the normal place at home time.

## Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> July - 3.30 - 5pm Parent Walkabout

Parents are invited into school to speak with their child's current class teacher if they have any questions about their Record of Achievement, as well as spend time visiting their child's new classroom. Our new teachers will be in school on this day so you can meet them.

#### Attendance

Children's attendance at school at this young age is so important – if children are regularly absent, there will be gaps in their learning that are very difficult to fill and this can impact upon their confidence and self-esteem, as well as their chances of reaching their potential academically. Our target as a school is to achieve 96% attendance for the year. Please see below attendance rates for the whole school, year groups and classes. As you can see, our figures are lower than our target.

#### Leave of absences

We have had several parents requesting leave of absences recently. We follow the LA attendance pathway and leave of absences are very rarely authorised, which means that any parents taking children out of school during term time will be fined. The fine is £60 per parent, per child for the absence. If more than one holiday is taken in 12 months, there may be court action taken against you.
