kit on this day and we will send their kits home with them the night before. Parents and carers are more than welcome to join us for Sports Day. We normally finish the morning at about 11.30am. You can stay for the whole session or part of the morning.

Transition Plans

Please see below the outline of key information and dates that we have planned next half term to support you and your children through transition into their next year group:

Friday 11th July

Record of Achievement

Each child will come home with their Record of Achievement, which will detail their end of year assessments, attendance record and a class 'Pen Portrait' will also be included so you and your child are aware of their new class staff team. Children in Year 1 will also have their Phonics Screening Check result and children in F2 will have their EYFS Profile results.

Tuesday 15th July - Thursday 17th July Transition visits

All children in school will move up to their new class for three full days. You will bring and collect your children as normal and we will organise them into their new classes once we have taken the register in their existing classroom. Children will then return to their class at the end of the day ready for collection at the normal place at home time.

Wednesday 16th July - 3.30 - 5PM

Parent Walkabout

Parents are invited into school to speak with their child's current class teacher if they have any questions about their Record of Achievement, as well as spend time visiting their child's new classroom. Our new teachers will be in school on this day so you can meet them.

PTA Summer Fair

Our amazing PTA are busy planning our final event of the year – our annual Summer Fair! It will be held on Friday 18th July from 2.30pm – 4pm. I am sure it is going to be just as amazing as last year! The poster about this event has been shared on the website and on Google Classroom – please take a look as there are key things happening throughout the day that you need to be aware of.

We are going to once again run our Rainbow Stall. Each class has been given a colour and they can come dressed in this colour on Friday 12th July for a £1 donation. We are asking for donations of items in each colour from each class and then these items will be put out for sale. There is a competition for the class that donates the most items and makes the most money that day!

As well as donations for the Rainbow Stall, we will have a range of other stalls that you can donate items for – we would love donations of toys, items for tombola prizes, buns, cakes and books.

We will begin to take these donations from Monday 14th July.

After School Clubs - September

We are in the process of planning our after-school provision offer for September and a letter will be emailed next week with an online form for you to choose these for your child. We will let you know before the end of this term if your child has secured a place.

Purchasing Uniform

We wanted to make you aware that due to the first couple of weeks in September being particularly busy, we will not be able to sell uniform during this time. We are asking parents to purchase any uniform they need for September now so that you are fully prepared. Please just log on to your Arbor App and go to the shop to do this. If you are unsure about sizing, just pop into reception and we can show you the items so you can check this for your child. If you have younger children joining us in September, you are fine to order uniform for your younger child on your existing account. Thank you.

Attendance

Children's attendance at school at this young age is so important – if children are regularly absent, there will be gaps in their learning that are very difficult to fill and this can impact upon their confidence and self-esteem, as well as their chances of reaching their potential academically. Our target as a school is to achieve 96% attendance for the year. Our attendance for the year currently sits at 94.7%. This figure is lower than our target. Please help us to increase this over the last few weeks of term by sending your child every day.

Leave of absences

We have had several parents requesting leave of absences recently. We follow the LA attendance pathway and leave of absences are very rarely authorised, which means that any parents taking children out of school during term time will be fined. The fine is £80 per parent, per child for the absence, if it is paid within 21 days. If more than one holiday is taken in 12 months, there may be court action taken against you.
