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Communication to parents needs to improve – more notice of events etc	- Information is shared very regularly via the app & Google Classroom. Reminders are sent but parents also need to be proactive and check the school calendar regularly. - New parent news display board will be added to more consistently.
Parents would like more information about what children are learning	- Weekly posts on google classroom share children's learning each week. - Subject leaders will add knowledge organisers for each of the subjects so parents have an overview of what is being learnt across the curriculum each half term.
Parents do not understand the role of governors	- Communication governor will share what governors are getting up to each time they visit school on the website – governors blog - Information sheet to be created about each of the governors to share what their role is and why it is important 'Contact Us' page added on governor page on website so parents can contact governing board directly if needed
Some parents unhappy with new timing of the start of the school day	We have had to implement this new change as the government have stipulated 32.5 hours teaching time in school. School doors open at 8.40am but children are not late until after 8.50am. School doors have to close at 8.45am for safeguarding purposes.
Wraparound care – parents need more childcare support than the current offer	New Tea Club wraparound provision being trialled from February 2025, which will then give parents 10 hours childcare per day if needed. This will be monitored closely and if there is not enough take up, it will not continue after March 2026.
