Dear Parents & Carers.

As part of our school improvement work around reading this year, we are developing different ways to support our children to foster a love for reading as well as further embedding the skills they need to become fluent and confident readers. As part of this work, we are planning on taking our Foundation Stage classes to the local library in Wickersley where they will be able to find out about what happens there, how they can loan books and they will also take part in an engaging story time session with the lead librarian. As well as developing their love of reading and understanding of how a library works, the children will also be learning about the local area and the important role a library plays within the community.

The visit will take place during the school day so children can be brought to school and collected at the normal times. Children will need to wear their school uniform for the visit.
