We believe this is achievable through a combination of strong, high quality, discrete phonics teaching combined with a literature rich approach that promotes a 'reading for pleasure' culture. We aim for all the children at Southbroom Infants to leave school with a genuine passion for reading and to have obtained all the skills they need to tackle any book of their choosing.

As a school we want children to continue to have access to high quality texts. We understand that occasionally texts may be misplaced or damaged at home but any lost titles need to be replaced by the school. We will charge £5 for any books which are not returned to school.
