## What did we learn about last half term?

Our focus for last half term in history was the Anglo-Saxons. Firstly, we looked at where the Anglo-Saxon period falls on a timeline in relation to the other periods of time that we have studied in previous year groups. After that, we researched and created fact files to explain different aspects of Anglo-Saxon life including: why they invaded Britain; where they settled; their homes; as well as looking at the lives of the rich and poor from that time period.

In art, we learned looked at the artist, Rembrandt. We used the primary colours to create a skin tone palette. Next, we used sketching skills to plan a portrait of a chosen celebrity, we looked specifically at the positioning of facial features. We then painted our sketches in the style of Rembrandt using natural tones. To end an amazing half term, we then got to show our final products off at the art exhibition!



## What are we learning this half term?

This half term, we will be reading 'A Planet Full of Plastic' by Neal Layton. We will be looking at the impact plastic has on our world as well as writing a setting description and a persuasive piece of writing. In geography, we will be studying coastal features and how these have changed over time. In DT, we will be looking at creating a lighthouse structure. As part of the structure, we will create an electrical circuit so that our lighthouse has a working light.
