As a school, we have to focus on learning and supporting the children in catching up after already missing so much learning time over the last two years. I would not want jeopardise the excellent progress that children have made so far.

I would rather choose to cancel these events so that we can still have our nativity performance and carol concert. We also have many other activities, such as Magic Carpet Theatre and Christmas parties, which we will be able to run safely in school.

We shall still hold the big raffle and plan to hold some of the Christmas Fair events on the playground at a different time.

#### COVID-19

Thank you to everyone for your support with our efforts to keep school free of Covid-19. We are continuing with extra cleaning routines, regular sanitising and ensuring that school is well-ventilated.

However, cases are rising across the city and the last thing we want is to be told by public health that we have to close classes or switch to remote learning.

So, with that in mind, please ensure that if your child develops any covid symptoms, you take them for a PCR test at the fire station. The results are normally sent to you the next day and the symptoms to look out for are: a new cough; a high temperature; loss of taste or smell.
