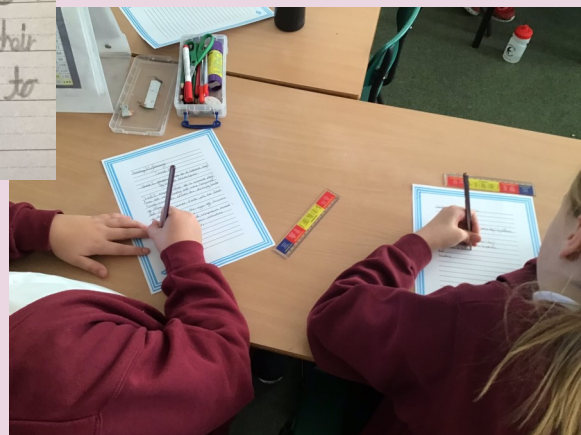
Beautiful Handwriting
