<u>Attendance</u>

So far we have 114 children who have over 96% attendance for the school year. Everybody who achieves 96% attendance for the whole year will be entered into a prize draw to win a Samsung tablet computer.

We still have 7 weeks of the school year left, so if you are currently below 96%, there is plenty of time left to improve.

As well as this we have 21 pupils who have 100% attendance for the whole school year - each of these children will receive a voucher to spend at Smyth's Toy Superstore if they can maintain their 100% record.

Please Remember: Uniform and Scooters

It's great to see so many children coming to school on bikes or on scooters but please remember that there should be no cycling or scooting on the playground. We regularly have over 1,000 people passing through the site at the end of the day and it is particularly dangerous near our 3 gates. We ask that you please remind your children of this as we have had a few near misses recently.

Please can we also remind you of our school uniform rules. Children are not allowed to wear sandals or crocs for school. These are not deemed to be safe footwear for school. Please also remind your children that jewelry, make-up or nail varnish are not permitted. The only exception to this is plain stud earrings which children must be able to remove themselves for PE. Thank you.
