This is an excellent opportunity for those children to see a professional performance from a world renowned theatre company. The show will be in the afternoon and the RSC will perform a version of Romeo and Juliet, a play that children in years 5 and 6 have already studied this year. We will also be able to offer tickets for this performance to families so that you can enjoy this experience with your children. The performance is part of the RSC's 'First Encounters' programme - theatre shows that are designed specifically for children as an introduction to Shakespeare. As we are an RSC Lead Associate school, we have managed to secure performances in school while the RSC are also performing at Hull Truck Theatre that week.
