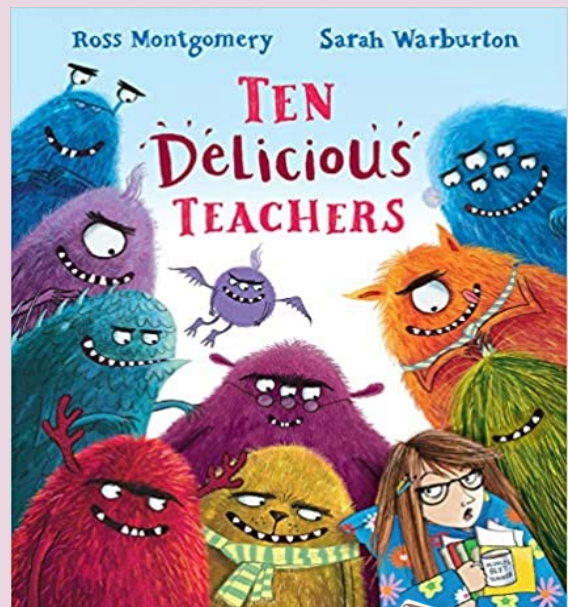
These events included New Age Curling, Bowling, Quidditch, Tri Golf and various relay events. They all had a fantastic time trying new activities.
