Early Years

What did we learn last half term?

Last half term, children in the Early Years did lots of learning about our theme 'All About Me' In English, we read a range of stories about starting school, why we are all special and about different types of families. What are we learning this half term?

- Try to help your child learn their numbers to 10. This could be done through counting games or nursery rhymes like '5 little ducks'.
- Support your child to hold a knife and fork correctly when eating at home.
