What were KS1 learning in Autumn 2?

In Autumn 2, KS1 enjoyed learning about the continents and oceans of the world. We learnt about the North and South Pole and which animals live there. In science, we loved learning about different types of animals, especially Emperor Penguins. In D&T, we made our own 3D pop-up penguin cards. In English, we used the story 'Lost and Found' to write our own stories about a boy who was helping a lost penguin to find his way home.



Spring 1 - A Stitch in Time: Magical Memories

This half term, in English, we will be using the story 'Wilfrid Gordon McDonald Partridge' to help us to write diary entries about finding and collecting memories.

In history, we will be learning about the changes which have happened in our own lives and we'll be placing these on a timeline. We will be learning about how toys and technology have changed over time, from the Victorian Era to the Modern Era. This links to our learning from Autumn 1! The key knowledge we want the children to learn this half term is that technology is always evolving. We want the children to be able to talk about the differences in technology from when their grandparents/parents were younger to their toys now.

In design and technology, we will be learning how to sew. We will be designing and making our own patchwork square, stitching on our own initials.

How you can help at home:

- Please listen to your child read his/her reading book at least three times a week. Ask your child questions about what they have read.
- Read fun bedtime stories with your child. Did you know that there is a library at The Freedom Centre where you can borrow some fantastic books?
- Encourage your child to dress themselves and tie their own shoelaces.
- Count to 100 and back each day.
- Practice letter formation and sitting letters on the line. In Year 2, the children start to use lead-ins to join their writing.
