What were Year 3 and 4 learning in Summer 1?

Last half term we studied how life changed from the Stone Age, though to the Bronze age and the Iron age. We created timelines looking at the key events. We also researched the housing, weapons and clothing used within this time and compared them to the present day.

In art, we studied the famous illustrator Quentin Blake. We imitated his artwork by drawing our own woolly mammoths from the book 'The Ice Monster', using water colours and black pen outlines.





Summer 2 - Survival of the Fittest: Deadly Sixty

This half term in Year 3/4, we will be focusing on the physical features of areas around the globe, looking at the UK, Switzerland and Brazil. We will be looking at differing landscapes including woodlands, rainforests and mountains whilst looking at the animals that live in these habitats. We will be revisiting and learning map work skills by locating continents, countries and discussing lines of longitude and latitude.

In design and technology, we will be creating a poster using mechanical systems like levers and linkages to move parts of an animal's body.
