## What are we learning this half term?

In history, we will be learning all about World War Two; key dates, who was sent to fight and using sources of evidence to find out about significant roles of women.

We will study watercolour painting in art and create a WWII Blitz painting, inspired by landscape artists, such as Oliver Pyle.

We are also looking forward to showing our art work in the exhibition at the end of the half term!
