What did we learn about last half term?

Our focus for last half term was Planet Earth: Disaster! In geography, we recapped the continents and oceans of the world, then learned about the causes of natural disasters (including earthquakes and tsunamis). After that, we researched the physical geography of the United Kingdom, Italy and California in order to compare the areas and identify any similarities. In DT, we learned about the techniques which are used to strengthen structures and the designs of engineer Robert Stephenson. We used this knowledge to design, then construct an earthquake-proof model

What are we learning this half term?

In history, we will be studying the Anglo-Saxons. We will look at when and why they invaded Britain and how they lived when they settled here. We will be acting like historians to interrogate artefacts to see what we can find out about Anglo-Saxon people.

In art, we will be learning about the artist Rembrandt. We will be using acrylic paints to paint our own portrait of an Anglo-Saxon man or woman.
